## Eyes On Asia

For five years, photographer Fredric Roberts has traveled extensively throughout South Asia capturing with his lens the essence of people living in India, Cambodia, Bhutan, Thailand and China. Taken in Pushkar, India, this image blends elements of still and motion, a combination that has become a signature of Roberts' work. The photograph is one of 26 to go on exhibit at the Rubin Museum in New York City starting September 29. Of the photographer, guest curator Deborah Willis, Ph.D., writes, "Interested in the visual noise in the photograph as well as the silence found in making the image, Roberts uses motion to create quilt-like forms and patterns incorporating details often overlooked."
